The Software Engineering Institute (SEI) is announcing the publication in November 2010 of CMMI version 1.3. This version aims to finalize the harmonization of the 3 CMMI constellations DEV, ACQ and SVC that was initiated with version 1.2. In each of the future constellation release, a consistent terminology and glossary will be used, an identical pattern of presentation of the generic practices in a special chapter will be applied, an update of the informational material and examples will be done to take into account the evolution of the state of the art, and finally an important addition of explanations will be made for level 4 and 5. Despite this version will not significantly impact the already institutionalized best practices in organizations that deployed CMMI version 1.2, it will be helpful for these organizations (whatever their CMMI maturity level) to get advanced notice of the future changes in order to plan their transition. This is particularly true for those aiming level 4 and 5.
